ORDINANCE NO. 121

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE STRASBURG TOWNSHIP TRAFFIC AND PARKING ORDINANCE, ORDINANCE NO. 34, TO IMPOSE A SPEED LIMITATION ON CREEK VIEW LANE.

BE AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Strasburg, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

Section 1. The Strasburg Township Traffic and Parking Ordinance, Ordinance No. 34, Article II, Traffic Regulations, Section 1, Maximum Speed Limits Established on Certain Streets, Subsection (a), shall be amended by adding the following speed limitation in alphabetical order:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Between</u>	<u>Maximum Speed Limit</u>
Creek View Lane	Entire Length	25 mph

Section 2. All other sections, parts and provisions of the Strasburg Township Traffic and Parking Ordinance, Ordinance No. 34, shall remain in full force and effect as previously enacted and amended.

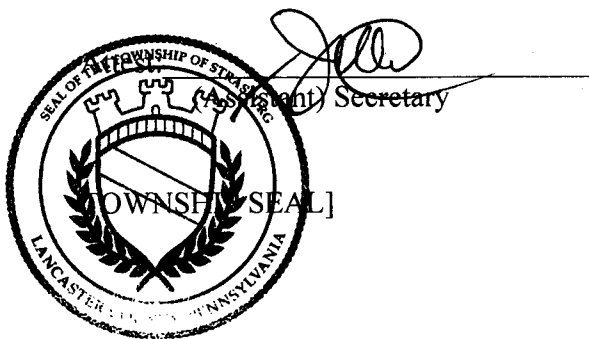
Section 3. In the event any provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, illegal or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity, illegality or unconstitutionality shall not affect or impair the remaining provisions, sections, sentences, clauses or parts of this Ordinance, it being the intent of the Board of Supervisors that the remainder of the Ordinance shall be and shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its enactment by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Strasburg as provided by law.

Notice is hereby given that the Strasburg Township Board of Supervisors at its meeting on Monday, March 4, 2024, at 7:00 p.m., at the Strasburg Township Municipal Building, 400 Bunker Hill Road, Strasburg, Pennsylvania, shall consider, and, if appropriate, at that meeting or a subsequent public meeting within 60 days of the date of publication of this advertisement, shall enact an ordinance, the caption of which is as follows:

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE STRASBURG TOWNSHIP TRAFFIC AND PARKING ORDINANCE, ORDINANCE NO. 34, TO IMPOSE A SPEED LIMITATION ON CREEK VIEW LANE.

The proposed ordinance may be summarized as follows. Section 1 establishes a 25 mile per hour speed limit on Creek View Lane. Sections 2 – 4 reaffirm all other parts and provisions of Ordinance No. 34, provide for severability of any invalid provisions, and set forth the effective date. A copy may be examined without charge at the offices of this newspaper and at the Strasburg Township Municipal Building, 400 Bunker Hill Road, Strasburg, Pennsylvania, Mondays from 9:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m., Tuesdays and Wednesdays 12:00 p.m. until 5:00 p.m. A copy of the proposed ordinance may be obtained for the cost of reproduction at the Strasburg Township Municipal Building during the above hours.



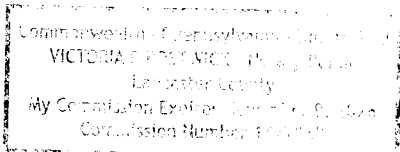

In accordance with the authorization of the Board of Supervisors at its meeting on February 5, 2024, I have prepared and advertised an ordinance to establish a 25 mile per hour speed limit on Creek View Lane for the Board's meeting on March 4, 2024.
